1.1 This Standard covers mandatory requirements governing the design and installation of Category III, Security Perimeter Fencing for Saudi Aramco's vital industrial facilities per SAES-O-100, paragraph 1.3.

1.2 This Standard shall be used in conjunction with Safety and Security Directive No. 3 (SSD/3) of the Saudi Arabian Government Supreme Commission for Industrial Security.

2 Conflicts and Deviations

- 2.1 All conflicts between Standards, Requisitions for Material, related Specifications, Codes, Forms, Drawings and other documents shall be resolved as per SAES-O-100, paragraph 4.4.
